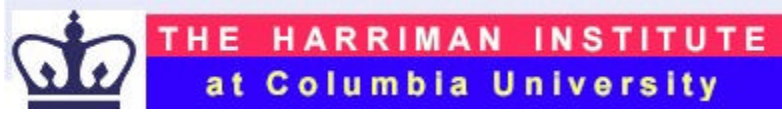
Transcript
