A professor emeritus at Sciences Po, **Jean Leca** is a renowned specialist of political philosophy and political sociology, with specific interest in the Arab world and the Mediterranean. Jean Leca is the former President of the International Political Science Association (1991-1994) and of the French Political Science Association (1990-1991 and 1998-2005). He has consulted widely regarding Arab foreign relations and was a member of the Joint Committee on the Near and Middle East. Jean Leca has held various visiting professor positions in the US, including Stanford, Princeton, Dartmouth, and University of Wisconsin, Madison.
